

2014 Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

COUNTY OF UVALDE

According to the Texas Comptroller's Truth-in-Taxation guide dated July 2005, "Section 26.05(d) requires a taxing unit to hold two public hearings and publish newspaper ads before adopting a tax rate that exceeds the rollback rate or the effective tax rate." The Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase and Notice of Vote on Tax Rate are required if adopting a tax rate that exceeds the lower of the rollback rate or the effective tax rate

Comparison of Residence Homestead Taxes

The taxes that would have been imposed in the preceding tax year on a residence homestead at the average appraised value (excluding special exemptions for person 65 years of age or older or disabled) are estimated to be \$609.42. The taxes that would be imposed in the current tax year on the residence homestead appraised at the average appraised value in the current tax year (excluding special exemptions for person 65 years of age or older or disabled), if the proposed tax rate is adopted, are estimated to be \$601.91. The difference between the amount of the taxes on the average residence homestead in the current tax year, if the proposed tax rate is adopted, and the preceding tax year would be a decrease of \$7.51 of taxes.
