Mitchell, Uvalde County Judge of Uvalde County, Texas will receive bids for construction of the **Knippa, Texas 2024 Water Improvements, TxCDBG Contract No. CFC23-0222** until <u>Tuesday, December 3, 2024 at 2:00 PM</u> at the Uvalde County Courthouse, 100 N. Getty Street, Uvalde, Texas 78801. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this place and time. Any bid received after closing time will be returned unopened. Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

Principal items of construction include approximately 2,485 LF of 4" PVC water line, 920 LF of 6" PVC water line, and all necessary appurtenances and water service reconnections.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to Uvalde County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. Attention is called to the fact that the Buy America Build America Act (BABA) pertains to this project. All iron and steel used in this project must be produced in the United States. Attention is called to the fact that not less than the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.
