



ORDER SETTING UVALDE COUNTY, TEXAS TAX RATE FOR 2017

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Uvalde County Commissioners Court to set the tax levy in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Uvalde County residents:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

That there is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for 2017 an ad valorem tax of \$.7409 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2017 tax rolls.

THIS RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAX REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 4.14 PER CENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$ 29.20.

That this tax rate is adopted in the following components:

General Fund Maintenance & Operations Tax Rate	.5257
I&S Rate for 2009 Series Certificates of Obligations	.0950
Farm to Market-Flood Maintenance & Operations Tax Rate	<u>.1202</u>
2017 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	.7409

That the Uvalde County Appraisal District is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2017 tax statements and transmit same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before October 1, 2017, or as soon thereafter as possible.
