BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 11th day of February, 2019, the Honorable Commissioners Court of Uvalde County, Texas convened in the Commissioners' Courtroom of the Uvalde County Courthouse. The following members were in attendance:

1. Consider and act upon call to order, invocation and pledge of allegiance:

The Honorable William R. Mitchell called the meeting of February 11, 2019 to order at 10:00 AM with the invocation led by Commissioner Garza followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and Texas Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Consider and act upon approval of minutes:

Motion by Commissioner Bates to approve the minutes of January 28, 2019.
Seconded by Commissioner Pargas.
The motion unanimously carried (3-0).

3. Consider and act upon acknowledgement and recognition of County Service Officer for certification and accreditation with the Texas Veterans Commission:

Texas Veterans Commission Executive Director Thomas P. Palladino provided a letter informing the Court that Uvalde County Veterans Service Officer Everardo "Lalo" Zamora has completed the required annual training and will maintain his Veteran County Service Officer certification. Mr. Zamora received accreditation through the Texas Veterans Commission.

4. Consider and act upon order permitting sale of fireworks during the Texas Independence Day period of February 25 through March 2:

The Court considered an order authorizing the sale of fireworks during the Texas Independence Day holiday period of February 25 through March 2, 2019. State statute requires the adoption of this order prior to February 15, 2019.

Motion by Commissioner Pargas to approve order permitting sale of fireworks.

FIREWORKS SALES**


WHEREAS The Commissioners Court of Uvalde County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202 (h)(1), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of **Texas Independence Day**; and

WHEREAS On the 11th day of February, 2019, the Commissioners Court of Uvalde County determined that conditions are favorable to issue an Order;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Uvalde County adopts tis Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Texas Independence Day period beginning February 25, 2019 and ending March 2, 2019, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Serve determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, March 2, 2019, whichever is earlier.
