1. Consider and act upon call to order, invocation and pledge of allegiance:

2. Consider and act upon approval of minutes:

3. Consider and act upon award of architectural services for courthouse annex:

County Consultant Carl Esser outlined to the Court the proposals received for architectural services related to the Courthouse Annex. Four proposals were received from; Lopez Salas Architects, Debra J. Dockery, Architect, Slay Architecture and Davis Powell Architecture and opened on July 9, 2021.
