- **CCT SEPT** 14 **SECOND PUBLIC HEARING** (may not be earlier than 3 days after first public hearing); schedule and announce meeting to adopt tax rate 3-14 days from this date.
- CCT SEPT 20 "Notice Tax Revenue Increase" published before meeting\* to adopt tax rate is the second quarter-page notice in newspaper before meeting and published on TV and Web site (if available, at least seven days before meeting).
- CCT SEPT 17- 72-hour notice for meeting at which governing body will adopt tax rate. (Open Meetings Notice).
- CCT SEPT 22MEETING to adopt tax rate. Meeting is 3 to 14 days after second public<br/>hearing. Taxing unit must adopt tax rate by Sept. 29 or 60 days after<br/>receiving certified appraisal roll, whichever is later.
