Sept 16	Notice Tax Revenue Increase published before meeting to adopt tax rate is the second quarter-page notice in newspaper before meeting and published on TV and Web site (if available, at least seven days before meeting).
Sept 19	72-hour notice for meeting at which governing body will adopt tax rate. (Open Meetings Notice).
Sept 24 - CCT	MEETING to adopt tax rate. Meeting is 3 to 14 days after second public hearing. Taxing unit must adopt tax rate by Sept. 29 or 60 days after receiving certified appraisal roll, whichever is later.
