TRIAL SETTING

At _____ a.m./p.m. – **FINAL PRETRIAL HEARING/Art. 28.01 HEARING**

DOCKET. If any evidentiary motion is to be presented, the **defense shall notify the state at least seven days** prior to the 28.01 date so that they can secure the attendance of necessary witnesses. All Art. 28.01 Motions must be filed and served upon the other side at least 14 days prior thereto (rather than the seven days provided in the C.C.P.). The Defendant, State and Defense Counsel must sign and file the Acknowledgment of Receipt of Discovery and Receipt of Plea Offer at this hearing. **All witness lists are to be filed and exchanged at this hearing along with election of punishment and application for probation (if applicable).** **REQUIREMENTS If Plea Agreement Reached:** File with the clerk the promulgated plea bargain agreement and a written waiver of jury trial, each signed by the defendant and both lawyers. If necessary, send the defendant immediately to CSCD for preparation of a PSI (or notify CSCD if defendant is in jail). **The plea must be fully paper-ready at this time. No court time will be taken to prepare papers.**

At _____ a.m. – **JURY TRIAL/BENCH TRIAL.** On this day defendants and attorneys must appear and have Motions in Limine and any pending pretrial matters **heard at 8:30 a.m.**

The proposed jury charge and other pretrial submissions are required by 3:00 p.m. on Friday prior to the trial date.
