Description & Duties: Must be at least eighteen (18) years old, be a U.S. citizen, or naturalized alien,

Must possess at least a high school diploma / G.E.D.,

Must not have been convicted of a Class "B" misdemeanor or above,

Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screening, physical and psychological exam.

If not currently licensed, must successfully complete certified Jailers Academy and pass state licensing exam.

Must be able to walk, climb stairs/ladders, bend, lift, and twist, and lift at least fifty (50) pounds.

Work in extreme heat and/or cold, work rotating shifts of twelve (12) hour duration 6:00 a.m./6:00 p.m., four (4) days on, and four (4) days off.

<u>Responsible for:</u> Maintain custody and control of inmates within the jail complex,

Supervising inmate activities such as recreation, feeding, visitation and other functions.

Responding to emergency situations such as inmate fights, assaults, suicide, riot, or disturbance.
