## NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.7400 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of COUNTY OF UVALDE.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.7400 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.7400 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.7754 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for COUNTY OF UVALDE from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that COUNTY OF UVALDE may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that COUNTY OF UVALDE is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2020 at 10:00 AM at ZOOM HEARING: [www.uvaldecountry.com/youtube/commissionerscourt](http://www.uvaldecountry.com/youtube/commissionerscourt).

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, COUNTY OF UVALDE is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting UVALDE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT of COUNTY OF UVALDE at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by COUNTY OF UVALDE last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by COUNTY OF UVALDE this year.

<b>Total tax rate (per \$100 of value)</b>	\$0.7508	\$0.7400	1% decrease
<b>Average homestead taxable value</b>	\$114,744	\$119,194	4% increase
<b>Tax on average homestead</b>	\$861	\$882	2% increase
<b>Total tax levy on all properties</b>	\$13,028,337	\$13,242,508	2% increase
